The complex was officially closed on Labor Day, Monday the 3rd, but was however open for a couple prescheduled tours throughout the month. The insurance claim was submitted for the replacement of the DCC system that was struck by lightning. For the end of our season, the system was run by the module layouts system. Currently we are waiting for further information from the insurance company to see if we can get a full replacement of all that was asked for.

During the meeting, it was discussed to open the museum during the fair next August, which we have been closed for, and many people thought it would be wise to be open. It was agreed that we would talk to the museum officials at some future point. The topic was tabled to be put on next month's meeting agenda.

The subject was brought up on being able to have the Warrants name be copyrighted so that our club is the only group to be able to send out newsletters under that name. The price of placing a copy write on our Warrant name was found to be averaging \$35 by a quick internet search and it was voted on that if this price is the true price, to go ahead and have it copyrighted. If the price is more or it is more complex than originally thought to do the legal filing, then the topic will be brought up at a future meeting for further discussion.

It seems inventorying and organizing has been one of the things many people want to get done. You know all that stuff the club owns? The junk some people call it. All of those random unorganized items that have been hiding underneath the depot layout for years? They have finally been moved over to the module store and are finally being organized. It seems the club is finding more things than they originally thought that they didn't have or were out of every day in this pile. So one day maybe, we'll get through the entire museum and have a place for everything.

There has been another donation. This time it wasn't from our own backyard. The items donated came from Mike Flatley, the son of Clayton "Pat" Flatley, and were brought back all the way from Maryland. The donations consisted of many items include rolling stock, engines, books, and multiple buildings, totaling twelve boxes of items. Thank you Mr. Flatley for your generosity.

The modules have a new home! Thanks to Tom Thelig for finding them our new home, the modules are now located in the old Family Dollar store in the Trig's mall. Work is being done on them almost daily with the scenery on all but three sections almost done. Along with that, the curtains have been put up and hang well. The sides of the Styrofoam have also been painted, along with parts of the layout frame.

The wiring has been hooked up and was found to be

in good working order and the tracks have been connected, with rail joiners going in easily. The setup of the modules has been almost perfected for moving the layout and is now almost an ease for the members to do.

The module system is taking its first show trip up to the annual train show and swap meet up in Minocqua WI on September 28th through the 30th. The club has also reserved a table to sell our old rolling stock on at a price of \$25. The rolling stock that is to be sold is cars that are extra off the club layout and things that have been found underneath the depot layout.

The club will be holding clinics on running the DCC system. The date has not been set due to having to get the module layout ready. The date should be set during the October business meeting.

The employees of the depot that run the tours have had a meeting regarding the improvements ideas to the depot end of the museum. The preliminary listing of improvements include-

Outside the Depot-

- Finish the painting and repair on the caboose and business car
- Shot blasting and painting of the engine
- Try to find funding to build a roof over engine
- Fencing in and redoing accommodations for the speeder rides
- Redoing back steps and wheelchair ramps

Inside the Depot-

- Cleaning and omitting double sets of items and restructuring the freight room; putting up fence and relabeling exhibit's
- Clean and rework the women's waiting room
- Put up new signs with arrow informing of layout downstairs
- Redo sign that says who we are and that we are a public service organization
- Set up new place for cash register and get more souvenirs to sell

This topic will be brought up at the October meeting for further review.
